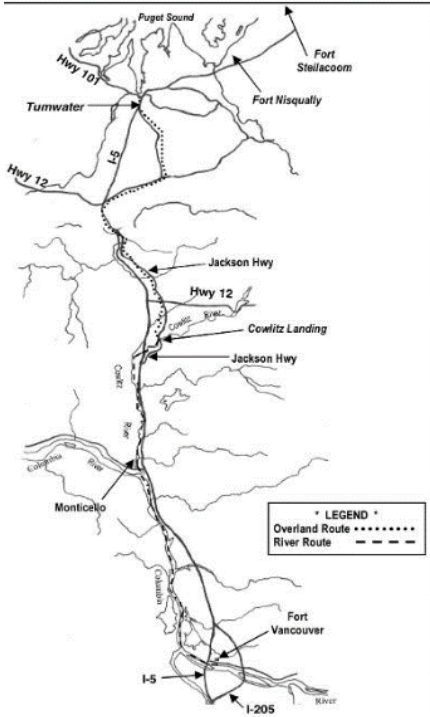


“Tumwater – Tenino – Toledo,”

Traversing the Cowlitz Trail, a Local History Rally / Tour



When: Saturday, August 20, 2022. Driver’s meeting 10:00 AM. Departure following.

Where: The tour will start at Sylvester Park, Capitol Way S and Legion Way SE, Olympia, WA.

Distance for the route is approximately 50 miles, but diversions and stops on the route will bring the distance closer to 75 miles. Driving and history notes will be provided at the driver’s meeting. You will see things and places of historical significance that you have not seen before, and things that you would drive past and have NO CLUE of events that transpired there.

Stops for sites and ‘Brit bites -people fuel’ will be made at Shona’s 570 Market Blvd. Chehalis, WA 98532 (They feature meat pies, cheeses, baps, pastries, coffee and tea.
