

Fall Color and Scavenger Hunt

Come join the fun as we embark on a grand weekend adventure.

On Saturday, we will travel North to Port Townsend and enjoy the sights and sounds of Port Townsend, the Kinetic Sculptures Race, and the Ft. Warden area before dining at Doc's Marina in Port Townsend.

On Sunday, we will take the ferry to Whidbey Island where a telephone scavenger hunt will take place. Confused? Don't be, the rules for the scavenger hunt will be explained on site Sunday morning once the ferry has landed. **A cell phone or digital camera that takes pictures is a requirement for this event.**

We will wrap up our trip at the Tap Room Bayview Corner on Whidbey Island for awards, lunch and fun!

When: October 5-6, 2024

Departure Time: The tour will depart from the Safeway parking lot in Gig Harbor following a short 8:00 drivers meeting. That location is 4831 Point Fosdick Dr, Gig Harbor. Take exit 10 (Olympic Drive) from Hwy 16. Seattle, **or North End members can meet the group at Shine Tidelands State Park boat ramp at approximately 9:30.**

Shine Tidelands is located on the beach **immediately** off the West side of the Hoods Canal Bridge. You can see the beach/park off to the right as you leave the bridge deck. Drive over bridge and take the first hard right off the bridge deck and then follow signs to the Shine Tidelands.

Where Are We Going: On Saturday we will travel to the Pt. Townsend area where members will be able to enjoy multiple activities in Port Townsend on Saturday. Dinner will be at Doc's Marina with the group.

On Sunday, we will take the ferry to the Coupeville/Ft. Casey State Park area where the scavenger hunt will be explained at the public boat launch area adjacent to the ferry slip. Those who can only come on Sunday, plan on meeting the ferry in the public boat launch area adjacent to the Coupeville ferry dock. Reservations on the Pt. Townsend-Coupeville ferry are strongly suggested and can be made at wsdot.wa.gov. Ferry sailing times will be shared once the fall schedule has been announced. The Sunday wrap-up lunch will be at the Tap Room Bayview Corner on Whidbey Island before tour participant head home in the direction that best serves their needs. You will most likely need a Discover Pass to visit the forts. If your MG is out of commission feel free to drive your daily driver for this fun event.
